Meeting Minutes

Update on Action Items/Discussions:

1. Dave Rausch - Chili school population projections.

- Looking for total enrollment projections for the 3 school districts on the west side of Monroe County: Churchville-Chili, Gates-Chili, and Wheatland-Chili.
- Cannot determine size of church simply based on attendance at Christmas and Easter. Don't want to overbuild or underbuild.

2. Bernard Grizard - our liaison with the diocese and Bishop Matano will be very involved in the process.

- In a recent meeting with Bishop Matano, Bernard stated the following:
  - o The Bishop is available any time.
  - o He commented that sprinkler systems are a “must.”
  - o He emphasized that SPX is rebuilding a “church,” not a “building.”
- Several meetings have taken place with Bernard, Fr. Paul, and Eric Patchke. Jamie Ott has been part of several of those meetings.

## 3. Bernie Iacovangelo -

- Bernie reported that he and other committee members met with the town officials recently. Needs:
  - o A set of drawings to make it a standalone building
  - o 4 points of egress (3 are there; can easily make 1 more egress)
  - o Sprinklers
  - o 2015 energy code
  - o ADA - American Disability Act (already compliant)
  - o Partitions for standalone are weather tight
  - o There will be some changes made to the Parish Center.

## 4. Fr. Paul - Parish Center Discussion

- Priorities:
  - o Separate the electric from the church and Parish Center
  - o Sprinkler system

## 5. Jim O'Reilly & Tom Bowers reported on alternate plans for the Flea Market. This remains a priority.
