St. Pius Tenth Rebuild Committee Meeting Minutes

Wednesday, June 10, 2015

Diocesan Updates on Rebuilding Project:

1. **Bernard Grizard** –*Diocesan Update*

- Bernard shared the meeting minutes with Bishop Matano, but he did not receive any comments since the Bishop is traveling this week.
- Fr. White wanted to let the Rebuilding Committee know that they are supportive, anxious to move forward in the right direction, and will continue prayer.

2. **Betsy McDermott & Eric Patchke** – *Discussion*

- Betsy handed out two visuals on timeline projections: 1. Rebuilding of Parish Center and 2. Rebuilding of Church Building.
- These are not complete timelines; they will continue to grow with each meeting.
- Discussed status of electrical.

3. **Eric Patchke** –*Rebuilding Committee Q/A:*

Q: Can Steps 1 (Electrical) and 2 (Sprinklers) of the Pre-Renovation Phase be done at the same time? A: Yes.

Q: Has RG&E been notified of the electrical changes? A: *Since we are not bringing in new electric service (coming off the same transformer), RG&E only needs to be made aware of it. From RG&E's perspective, there is no change. Same goes for the Church as well.*

Q: Have there been any discussions with the Town of Chili? A: *There have been 'no' discussions yet. Bernie Iacovangelo said they will want to review plans before things get changed. A meeting was scheduled for 6/23.*

Q: Will the main panel and the current subpanels be located in the Parish Center. A: Yes.

Q: When you do expect us to get into the Parish Center? A: *Once the electrical main service is moved from the Church to the Parish Center, the Church can then come down and the temporary wall in the Parish Center will be made weather tight.*

Church Plans:

5. Fr. Paul – Discussion

- Fr. Paul would like to add 2 new subcommittees: Church Interior Design Committee and Rebuild Finance Committee
- The Rebuilding Committee will have input on the external design (shape) of the church.
- Fundraising Committee:
 - Discussion of possible capital campaign and purchasing of memorials.
 - Example of memorials: if we want to purchase 10 stained glass windows, you can buy a memorial ‘in memory of’.
 - Look at overall campus, structures, & needs (build residence for priest but priority is the church).
 - Need to be transparent with all costs and why we’re choosing what we are choosing.

Renovation of Parish Center:

6. Brian Porter – kitchen designer:

- Brian contacted a commercial kitchen distributorship.
- Charlie Schrieber will bring brochures and an exploratory meeting was scheduled.

Flea Market:

7. Jim O’Reilly & Tom Bowers – Flea Market status:

- Met with the Flea Market Committee.
- It’s an emotional issue as well as a financial issue. It is clear now that this has to happen.
- Received a quote from A-Verdi (trailers). The tentative plan is:
 - 8 trailers, 8x40,
 - delivery, ramps, room to run power cords to hang lights, and
 - will bring in 4 trailers to start.
- Steve Oberst offered several classrooms.
- Nolan’s (tent rental) is revising the size of tent, 20x80; extended the tent rental to six weeks; 110 tables to rent.
- Will need volunteers to move the items from the trailers to the school. Fr. Paul will need a two-week notice to announce at the pulpit.
