 Meeting Minutes

Parish Center progress: Brian Porter (Chairperson) & Fr. Paul Bonacci

- The last two weeks have been very exciting because there has been visible progress:
 - Wallboard is up, taped, and sanded.
 - Interior sprinkler system is almost complete.
 - Walls are primed & painted; will wait until the end to paint a second coat.
 - Installations of ceiling grids and tiles began today in Luke/John/Matthew/Mark.
 - Hardy board going up on outside early next week; will be painting above the trim.
 - Roof is water tight and completed.
 - The original blinds were removed by ServePro, and the contractor will be coming in to measure for commercial grade blinds.
- Small setback: a new (updated) form had to be submitted to DOT to tap into the water supply. Waiting for approval from DOR attorney on easement.
 - Bernie Iacovangelo mentioned that the trench for the water line can be started from the building to the road before the easement agreement is signed and approved by DOT.
 - Starting construction next week to dig the water line for the sprinkler system, 8" water line to be dug down 4' deep.
- Electrician will run conduit for the lights on the west side of the parking lot, to the crucifix, to the lights by Chili Ave, and hopefully to the bell tower.
- Bernie Iacovangelo also suggested that we start a new overall site plan of the changes. Brian Porter said that Nichols is doing a master drawing (redrawing & updating) of the current site plan, and we will get a new drawing at the end of the project. All other drawings will be obsolete.
- Diocese ran the network line from the Parish Office to the Parish Center (free of charge).
- Time Warner also ran their cable over to the Parish Center. We will now have WiFi in the Parish Center.

- The subcommittee is in the process of choosing blinds for Matthew/Mark/Luke/John and Music rooms.
- They will contact the Diocese to check out the religious items that are available. There may be a charge depending on the parish they are coming from; prices can usually be negotiated. They were thinking of using these items for the Parish Center.

Finance Subcommittee: Lisa Cecere

- The Whole Campus and Finance Subcommittee met on 9/11/15.
- Lisa sent out a summary of the meeting listing the attendees, the purpose of the meeting, discussion topics (future of St. Pius campus & needs), and the goals of the combined committees.
