Scripture	Isaiah 22:19-23; Psalm 138; Romans 11:33-36; Matthew 16:13-20
Science	<p>Play with the idea of a solid foundation and make some OOBLECK</p> <p>What you need: 2 cups Corn Starch & 1 cup of Water</p> <p>What you do: mix together & play.</p> <p>The oobleck is a solid and a liquid.</p> <p>You need a solid foundation, but you also need to be flexible!</p>
